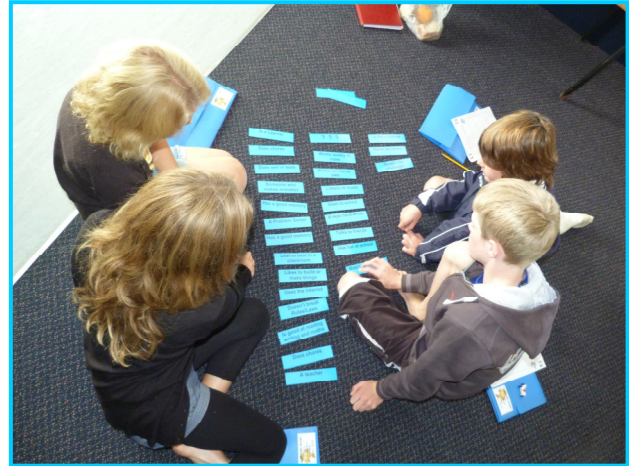


LEARNING AGENTS

Our learning agents had a great time working with the other learning agents from the Cambridge Rural area last week. They will be completing some research to find out how much our students know about being an ideal learner.

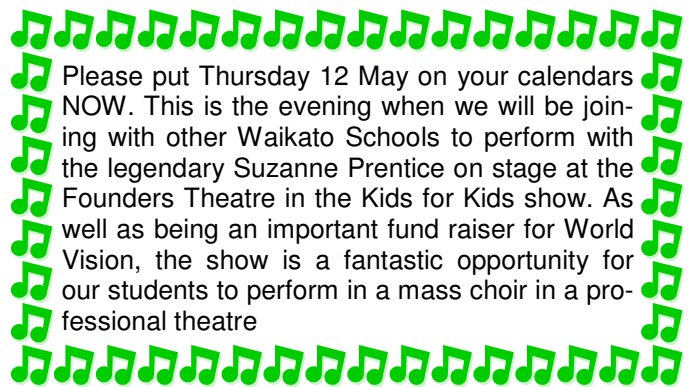


Left: Agents face some physical challenges at Extreme Edge.

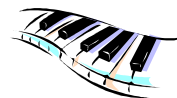
Congratulations to ex-pupil Nik Boyle who was named the Under 19 Player of the Year for the Waikato Valley Cricket Association.
